## Rules

- 1 A written copy of the piece must be sent to the section secretary BY THE CLOSING DATE.
- 2 All entrants should attend on the day of the Festival and the winners may read their piece or nominate an adult to do so.
- 3 The winner will be announced on the day of the Festival.
- 4 The time limits stated refer to performance duration and should be strictly observed (see General Rules).

## Classes

1. Entry Fee per person - £7 A short story of no more than 1,000 words, Age 10 & under, (Time limit 4 minutes)
2. Entry Fee per person - £8 A short story of no more than 1,500 words, Age 11 - 16, (Time limit 4 minutes)
3. Entry Fee per person - £7 A poem of no more than 40 lines, Age 10 & under, (Time limit 4 minutes)
4. Entry Fee per person - £8 A poem of no more than 40 lines, Age 11 - 16, (Time limit 4 minutes)

**Please note that the entry fee takes account of the work done by the adjudicator in judging entries prior to Festival day.**
