Rules

- 1 A written score, together with a recording of the piece, must be sent to the section secretary BY THE CLOSING DATE.
- 2 All entrants should attend on the day of the Festival and the three best attempts will be invited to perform their piece.
- 3 The winner will be announced on the day of the Festival.
- 4 The time limits stated refer to performance duration and should be strictly observed (see General Rules).

Classes

5. Entry Fee per person - £7 Age 7 & under, (Time limit 2 minutes)
6. Entry Fee per person - £8 Age 8 - 10, (Time limit 2 minutes)
7. Entry Fee per person - £9 Age 11 & 12, (Time limit 3 minutes)
8. Entry Fee per person - £10 Age 13 & 14, (Time limit 3 minutes)
9. Entry Fee per person - £11 Age 15 - 17, (Time limit 4 minutes)
10. Entry Fee per person - £12 Age 18 & over, (Time limit 4 minutes)

Please note that the entry fee takes account of the work done by the adjudicator in judging entries prior to Festival day.
