Rules

2 In order to ensure fairness and equality, no competitor will be permitted to practise on the piano to be used during the Festival. A separate practice room will be provided for the use of all competitors.

3 The time limits stated should be observed (please see General Rules).

Classes

ANY ONE PIECE COMPOSED BEFORE 1830

11. Entry Fee - £7 Any piece composed before 1830, Age 8 & under, (Time limit 3 minutes)
12. Entry Fee - £8 Any piece composed before 1830, Age 9 - 11, (Time limit 4 minutes)
13. Entry Fee - £9 Any piece composed before 1830, Age 12 - 14, (Time limit 5 minutes)
14. Entry Fee - £10 Any piece composed before 1830, Age 15-17, (Time limit 5 minutes)

ANY ONE ROMANTIC OR CONTEMPORARY PIECE

15. Entry Fee - £7 Any romantic or contemporary piece, Age 8 & under, (Time limit 3 minutes)
16. Entry Fee - £8 Any romantic or contemporary piece, Age 9 - 11, (Time limit 4 minutes)
17. Entry Fee - £9 Any romantic or contemporary piece, Age 12 - 14, (Time limit 5 minutes)
18. Entry Fee - £10 Any romantic or contemporary piece, Age 15-17, (Time limit 5 minutes)

ANY ONE PIECE OF JAZZ, BLUES OR RAG EITHER IMPROVISED OR FROM MUSIC

19. Entry Fee - £7 Any jazz, blues or rag either improvised or from music, Age 8 & under, (Time limit 3 minutes)
20. Entry Fee - £8 Any jazz, blues or rag either improvised or from music, Age 9 - 11, (Time limit 4 minutes)
21. Entry Fee - £9 Any jazz, blues or rag either improvised or from music, Age 12 - 14, (Time limit 5 minutes)
22. Entry Fee - £10 Any jazz, blues or rag either improvised or from music, Age 15-17, (Time limit 5 minutes)
23. Entry Fee - £12 Any jazz, blues or rag either improvised or from music, Age 18 & over, (Time limit 6 minutes)

ANY PIECE UNDER GRADE 1

24. Entry Fee - £7 Under Grade 1, Under Grade 1, (Time limit 3 minutes)

ONE PIECE FROM ANY EXAMINING BOARD SYLLABUS EITHER PAST OR PRESENT

25. Entry Fee - £7 Grades 1 & 2, Grades 1 & 2, (Time limit 3 minutes)

- 26. Entry Fee - £8 Grades 3 & 4, Grades 3 & 4, (Time limit 4 minutes)
- 27. Entry Fee - £9 Grades 5 & 6, Grades 5 & 6, (Time limit 5 minutes)
- 28. Entry Fee - £10 Grades 7 & 8, Grades 7 & 8, (Time limit 6 minutes)
- 29. Entry Fee - £11 Over Grade 8, Over Grade 8, (Time limit 8 minutes)

RECITAL CLASS - 2 CONTRASTING PIECES

- 30. Entry Fee - £14 Recital - 2 contrasting pieces, Age 12 - 17, (Time limit 12 minutes)
- 31. Entry Fee - £15 Recital - contrasting pieces, Age 18 & over, (Time limit 12 minutes)

DUET CLASSES - OWN CHOICE (ONE PIECE)

- 32. Entry fee - £10 Adult and child- own choice (one piece), Adult & child, (Time limit 5 minutes)
- 33. Entry fee - £8 Two children- own choice (one piece), Age 15-17, (Time limit 5 minutes)
